Blending art and fashion, he reinterprets symbols of luxury and pop culture.

His work is exhibited in many international galleries.

Fred Allard freezes movement and the ephemeral in blocks of plexiglass, capturing everyday objects—bags, sneakers, banknotes—as symbols of our time.

He questions the codes of consumption, fashion, and identity by turning these objects into timeless artworks.

His style, both raw and refined, explores the tension between art, design, and urban culture.



Their work, influenced by pop art and street art, playfully and provocatively revisits iconic figures from an entire generation. Their signature: giant slides blending screen printing, stenciling, and collage.

Their work is driven by an urgency to live fully. Through nostalgic yet socially engaged creations, they explore themes of time and social injustice. Their series of giant slides pays tribute to icons of the '70s and '80s, while their "uchronias" imagine alternate realities—such as the hypothetical marriage of Marilyn Monroe and John F. Kennedy.

Deeply committed, they also speak out against violence towards women, support research on rare diseases and also generously support Ohr Torah School.



VICTOR VASARELY

Victor Vasarely (1906–1997) was a French-Hungarian artist considered the father of Op Art. Trained at the Bauhaus in Budapest; he moved to Paris in 1930. His work focused on visual illusion, geometric forms, and color. He created an accessible, modular art often integrated into architecture and design. His work merges mathematical precision with visual impact.

Vasarely developed a visual language based on geometry, aiming to create optical vibrations in the viewer. By combining simple shapes with vivid colors, he explored effects of motion, depth, and transformation. He saw art as a game of perception—democratic and reproducible—and introduced the idea of "kinetic art" in which the eye becomes an active participant.
